Would He contend with me in the greatness of His power? No; but He would give heed to me. There an upright person could reason with Him, and I should be acquitted forever by my judge.

"If I go forward, He is not there; or backward, I cannot perceive Him; on the left He hides, and I cannot behold Him; I turn to the right, but I cannot see Him.


